A Message From Our CEO

The events of the past two years have turned the world upside down in unexpected and challenging ways. And for the low-opportunity communities that Elevate USA serves, these difficulties have been further intensified, culminating in what the American Academy of Pediatrics has declared a mental health crisis among our youth. We know this crisis is driven largely by one thing: **relational instability.**

We are not disheartened by this reality, but rather, determined by it. It's why we've worked tirelessly alongside leaders around the nation to launch four new affiliates in 2021: New Jersey, Birmingham, Atlanta, and Bridgeport.

In 2021, Teacher Mentors found innovative ways to connect with students inside and outside the classroom. For many of our young people, the Elevate classroom was the only place they could find stability in an ever-changing and chaotic world.

One thing is evident now more than ever: the model that began 40 years ago continues to be transformative and relevant in the lives of our students. Whether the challenge in our communities is education, mental health, healthcare, food-insecurity, poverty, or social justice, all have one common thread between them: the need for stable mentoring relationships.

I am extremely proud of the work that Elevate USA accomplished in 2021. The resilience of our communities, board, staff, and students shined brightly. **Thanks for being part of another incredible year.**

THE CHALLENGE

RELATIONAL INSTABILITY

The problems faced by young people in lowopportunity neighborhoods are vast and varied, but they can all typically be traced back to one thing: the fabric of their relationships.

In this new pandemic environment, young people are experiencing epidemic levels of loneliness.

SCHOOLS OVERWHELMED BY STUDENT NEED

The pandemic has brought learning loss, lost connection with caring adults, and increased depression, anxiety, isolation, irrational fears, and social withdrawal. While these losses are felt by almost everyone, they are disproportionately felt by students in economically disadvantaged communities.

40% feel that they are completely alone and have no one to talk to

THE CLASSROOM IS JUST HALF OF IT

Teacher Mentors spend 50% of their time in the classroom, and 50% of their time mentoring high school and junior high students after school, on weekends and throughout the summer. Mentoring includes one-on-one, small group, and large group activities.

How is Elevate USA different from Elevate Affiliates?

Elevate USA serves as the national organization for Elevate programs across the nation. The purpose of Elevate USA is to launch and support Elevate affiliates in cities throughout the country. Through the affiliation model, each city operates as its own separate 501(c)(3) organization with a separate board of directors and funding, while Elevate USA exists to help ensure their success.

Elevate USA guides each potential new affiliate from the initial stages of relationship to full implementation of the program model. Affiliate support includes coaching, training, toolkits, curriculum, program materials, best practice resources, national events, measurement and evaluation, networking, program fidelity oversight, and branding and messaging.

Elevate is solving the #1 problem faced by youth in American cities: relational insecurity.

This problem does not make headlines and it's far from simple. Akin to food insecurity, relational insecurity is centered around children who are deprived of the positive, caring, and long-term relationships required for human productivity and thriving.

About 20 years ago, I learned about the complex nature of relational insecurity and the intuitive Elevate solution. Since then, I have watched Elevate develop its processes, people, culture, and metrics measurement. The model has proven to be effective from the Mile-High City to the Atlantic Coast of Florida. But more than anything, I have seen our team unlock the human potential of young people, at scale, with the power of transformative mentoring relationships.

My family invests in Elevate because it is the most effective program of its kind in the country. We want to stay connected to this movement and help build future generations of thriving urban leaders.

MEET JOSH MENDOZA: FULL CIRCLE IMPACT

From Colorado UpLift student, to intern, to staff member, and now Lead Elevate Indy Teacher Mentor and Lead of Sports & Adventure programming.

During his sophomore year, Josh was faced with picking up the broken pieces of a fractured family. Having just been cured of leukemia a couple of years prior, he was no stranger to adversity, but nothing could have prepared him for when his dad walked away from their family, the same day his older brother left for the military.

Not long after this, he found himself inside of a Colorado UpLift classroom. The relationships he developed with those Teacher Mentors, paired with his tenacity of spirit, allowed Josh to succeed not despite the challenges of his adolescence, but because of the challenges he overcame.

Now, as a Lead Elevate Teacher Mentor, he is bridging the relationship gaps young people are facing today, just like the Teacher Mentors that went before him. This is what it looks like to build generations of thriving urban leaders.
